- Please Idle until well past pontoon and safely clear of traffic. (Incoming traffic will be crossing the lake from Panther Bay area through take-off)
- ALL FISH MUST BE PRESENTED FOR WEIGH-IN WITHIN 30 MINUTES of last angler weighed.
 (NOTE: ONLY Bass Cat clear plastic official weigh in bags will be accepted)
